Article. II.

Section. 1.

The executive Power shall be vested in a _____ of the United States of America. He shall hold his Office during the Term of four Years, and, _____ with the Vice President, chosen for the same Term, be elected, as follows:

Each State shall appoint, in such Manner as the _____ thereof may direct, a Number of Electors, equal to the whole Number of _____ and Representatives to which the State may be entitled in the _____: but no Senator or Representative, or Person holding an Office of Trust or Profit under the United States, shall be _____ an Elector.

The Congress may determine the Time of chusing the _____, and the Day on which they shall give their Votes; which Day shall be the same _____ the United States.

No Person except a natural born Citizen, or a Citizen of the United States, at the time of the _____ of this Constitution, shall be eligible to the Office of _____; neither shall any Person be eligible to that Office who shall not have _____ to the Age of thirty five Years, and been _____ Years a Resident within the United States.

The President shall, at stated Times, receive for his _____, a Compensation, which shall neither be increased nor diminished during the Period for which he shall have been elected, and he shall not receive within that Period any other _____ from the United States, or any of them.

Before he enter on the _____ of his Office, he shall take the following Oath or _____: "I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will _____ execute the Office of President of the United States, and will to the best of my Ability, _____, protect and defend the Constitution of the United States."

Section. 2.

The _____ shall be Commander in Chief of the Army and Navy of the United States, and of the Militia of the several States, when called into the actual Service of the United States; he may require the Opinion, in writing, of the _____ Officer in each of the executive Departments, upon any Subject _____ to the

Duties of their respective Offices, and he shall have Power to grant _____ and Pardons for Offences against the United States, except in Cases of _____.

He shall have Power, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Senate, to make _____, provided two thirds of the Senators present concur; and he shall _____, and by and with the Advice and Consent of the Senate, shall appoint _____, other public Ministers and Consuls, Judges of the supreme Court, and all other _____ of the United States, whose Appointments are not herein _____ provided for, and which shall be established by Law: but the _____ may by Law vest the Appointment of such inferior _____, as they think proper, in the President alone, in the Courts of Law, or in the Heads of _____.

The President shall have Power to fill up all _____ that may happen during the Recess of the Senate, by _____ Commissions which shall expire at the End of their next Session.

Section. 3.

He shall from time to time give to the _____ Information of the State of the Union, and recommend to their _____ such Measures as he shall judge necessary and expedient; he may, on _____ Occasions, convene both Houses, or either of them, and in Case of _____ between them, with Respect to the Time of Adjournment, he may adjourn them to such Time as he shall think proper; he shall receive _____ and other public Ministers; he shall take Care that the Laws be _____ executed, and shall Commission all the Officers of the United States.

The _____, Vice President and all civil Officers of the United States, shall be removed from Office on _____ for, and Conviction of, Treason, Bribery, or other high Crimes and _____.
